Benefits of Auditing

Evaluate the status of **work health and safety** in a hospitality environment to fulfil the **employer's legal obligation** in providing a workplace that *minimises the risk* to its **employees**, and consequently **patrons and guests**.

The outcomes of work health and safety auditing include:

- Formal review of workplace systems, practices, procedures and equipment
- Meeting compliance standards set by legislation, Codes of Practice, Australian Standards and facilitated by Department of Industrial Relations, WH&S Division inspectors
- Reduce the risk of common law claims
- Identification of hazards to reduce the risk to employees in the workplace
- Identification of unexpected deviations from established work practices or design
- Reinforcement of best practice, promotion of WH&S management and improved staff communication and education
